In Mathematics we are proud of:-

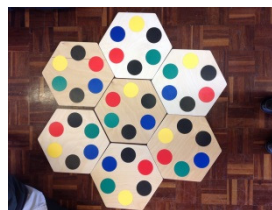
- The work we did on place value to millions including negative number, reading and writing 6 digit numbers and converting Roman numerals.
