# **A Parents Guide to Buckton Vale Primary School Behaviour Policy**

## **How we can help you**

Teachers are the first step to getting advice on how we can work together to support your children in making the right choices.

## **How you can help us**

Please support us by promoting a positive attitude towards school, learning and others by encouraging your children to do their best, behave responsibly and to follow our school values.

## **Dojo's**

Children can earn dojo points during their time at school. Teachers share their expectations with the class and these expectations are similar across KS1 and KS2. Children can earn or lose dojos in response to their behavior and a total amount is kept note of. The child with the most dojos at the end of the week earns a treat from the dojo box.

## **Gold**

Every child starts each day on gold.

## **Purple -1 dojo**

Once children have had a warning off the teacher, they move their name to Purple to think about the choice they are making.

## **Blue -2 dojo's**

If children have to be spoken to again they are moved on to blue and have to sit on an isolation table.

## **Yellow -5 dojo's**

If children continue to misbehave they are yellow carded and removed from the classroom.

## **A Positive Approach**

Children can earn their way back to Gold and earn dojos back by making the right choices in their learning.

We award one child per week for star of the week awards for good behaviour and positive attitudes to learning.
