Dear Parents/Carers,

Important changes

From 18th February 2017, Buckton Vale Primary School will become a cashless school. We will now use the online payment system School Money for all payments (with the exception of water bottles and charitable donations). **This will now include school meals. Please be reminded that school meals must be paid in advance. Any debts over one week will be followed up immediately.**

All parents/carers will receive a unique password via text message from school which will give you the website link to the login page at School Money where you can pay for school meals, trips, clubs etc.

Please familiarise yourself with the School Money system before 18th February as from this date school will no longer be accepting cash or cheques. There are user guides which show step by step instructions on how to login/pay/view history etc. Links to these user guides can be found on our school website.

If you currently pay for school meals via Tameside MBC's website, please now login to School Money to make any further payments directly to school.

If any parent/carer is in financial difficulty regarding payments of school meals, trips, etc, or you have any questions/queries please contact the school office.
