A message from Mrs Brown – BEHAVIOUR POLICY IMPROVEMENTS

As mentioned last week, our new Dojo Shop has been officially opened by Councillor Jan Jackson. The children have been busy shopping this week, after working hard and collecting 50 Dojo points. We are proud of how hard the children are working towards their Dojos and love the idea of all the positives.







In your feedback, some of you suggested you'd like to be informed of behaviour sooner than a yellow card. We agree. Therefore, and over the last few weeks, staff and school council members have been thinking about behaviour that warrants a purple, blue or yellow card. This makes it very clear what behaviour is acceptable. On Monday, I delivered a virtual assembly about our sanctions. If children are repeatedly on purple or blue they will now need to spend time reflecting on their actions, usually in a playtime or part of lunchtime. This will result in a telephone call home to you as parents. It is hoped this will prevent children getting yellow cards.

Due to the large number of emails from you as parents, we are still working on improvements to lunchtime behaviour with lots of new ideas already trailed this week. For example, children in Year 5 and 6 have been enjoying taking part in the 'Mile a Day' run on the field.

We really appreciate your ideas and feedback and will do our best to incorporate them into our new policy. Thank you for your patience whilst we try these new ideas out.

Congratulations to Jon Courtney – WINNER!



You won't have received the automated email to confirm the registration. The link that is in the email for you to click on expires after 7 days. After 7 days you can register again and you will receive the automated email as normal. Anyone who registered or submitted their application prior to 16th September or who don't have an outlook/Hotmail/live email address are not affected.
