BREAKFAST CLUB:



The breakfast club will open at 7.30am every school day during term time and is situated in a dedicated room in the main school building. Children should be dropped off by parents /carers at the main school gates facing the school office. The latest entry to the club will be 8.20am.

Whilst at the club, children will be offered a range of breakfast items such as cereals, toast, bagels and be provided with drinks, such as water or milk. Any child with a special dietary requirements will be catered for, please inform the staff at Beyond the Bell if this option is required.

Children can also choose from a wider range of games to play with whilst attending the club. Once the bell has been rung for school, children will join their classmates ready to begin the day.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB:



At 3.15pm children will attend the club. KS2 children will be able to walk from their classroom to the club, and KS1 children will be collected from their classroom by a member of staff. If a child is attending any enrichment activities provided by the school, they will be brought to the club by their teacher.

A healthy snack will be provided for all children attending the club. Any child with a special dietary requirements will be catered for, please inform the staff at Beyond the Bell if this option is required.

Whilst at the Club children can also choose from a wide range of activities to choose from such as Lego, reading, sports, arts and crafts, and board games. They are also able to play outside if the weather permits.

The afternoon sessions end at 4.15pm, 5.15pm and 5.45pm. Parents/Carers can collect their child from the main schools gates facing the school office at their prearranged time, only parents and carers on the agreed collection list will be allowed to collect from the club. Please inform Beyond the Bell staff if there are changes to the person collecting.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Accidents and Illnesses

- If a child falls ill or has an accident at the club, parents/carers will be contacted as soon as possible. A qualified member of staff will give first aid if needed. Please ensure that all emergency contact details held by the school are up to date along with any of the child's medical information. These can be checked on your Arbor account.



Medications

- Staff are only able to administer medications that have been prescribed by a doctor if a signed written consent form has been handed into the school office, and the medication is in the original packaging.



Behaviour and Discipline

- While attending the club, children are expected to treat other children and staff respectfully and courteously. Any behaviour issues will be discussed with parents/carers in the first instant and a school behaviours policy is in place.



Child Protection

- We take child protection very seriously and any suspected abuse will be reported to social services and the local safeguarding board immediately.



Equal Opportunities

- We operate an equal opportunities policy which applies to all staff and children. Copies of the policy can be found on the school website.



Complaints
