Roadworks Update: As you are aware there are road works on Buckton Vale Road which have been causing issues recently. This week we had a representative from Cadent in to do a Health & Safety Assembly for all our children. Mr Gambino gave an overview of the company and talked about Gas safety and the large holes they are digging which are around the area. We also requested an update on the roadworks. Unfortunately, they will be here for a while! Cadent are fitting new pipes to the whole area. They are now working on the Moorgate Estate and will be moving across to the Bowling Green area in the forthcoming weeks. Mr Gambino explained that they cannot carry out the work during the night because of the noise when digging and having to request properties to switch off their gas.

As the roadworks are continuing can we please ask that you take the delays into account when arriving at school. We are seeing a large increase in children arriving late. Remember gates open at 8.30am, doors & registers open at 8.35 and close at 8.55am Any child arriving after 8.55am will receive a late mark, which affect not only their learning, but their attendance too.
