



Buckton Vale Primary School PE Premium

During the school year of 2024-2025, Buckton Vale Primary School has received £18,090 to improve the quality of sport and PE provision. Our vision has been to continue to create a culture that encourages all children to be active and have positive attitudes towards physical activity and healthy lifestyles. We want all pupils leaving primary school to be physically literate and leave with the knowledge, skills, and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport. We also want to give children experiences that are broad and develop them as people through visits, competitions, festivals and visitors to school.

The funding has been allocated to:

- * Continue to achieve School Games Gold Status.
- * Become Tameside Champions in Lacrosse and Dodgeball, whilst also being finalists in Tag Rugby. We also reached the semi-finals in both the Holmes cup and the Heywood cup. We also reached Tameside Finals in 10 events this year.
- * Attend festivals in sports such as pickleball, Lacrosse, Jason Robinson Tag Rugby, Glow dodgeball, and Action sports. This has allowed us to have engaged more children than ever before in competition in school, with girls and children with SEND having the biggest year on year increase.
- * Attend coaching events at Man City with our year one and Reception children for the first time.
- * Allow year groups from Year two to Year six to attend Etihad festivals.
- * Buy into Tameside SSP to allow access to competitions, festivals and high quality CPD in sports such as Dance.
- * Provide extra-curricular clubs for those wanting to progress skills after school.

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- * Work with creating active schools to continue to ensure children get their 60 active minutes per day. We have made dinnertimes more active with the introduction of sports ambassadors running a variety of activities.
- * Give Leadership opportunities for the children through Young Ambassadors, FA Gamechangers. Children have regularly led events at dinner, after school and have supported during sports day.
- * Take part in sports events for the Victorious Academies trust in Dodgeball and netball as well as having friendlies in other sports.
- * Develop assemblies to share children's sporting achievements from home as well as celebrating sports tournaments each week. This has led to plans to do a Buckton Vale Sports Awards next year as well.
- * Invite Visitors and Taster days in school from the Ella Toone Foundation, Football Freestyler Ash Randall
- * Attended a Balance bike delivery course and have been delivering sessions for children in our EYFS.
- * Support in PE for teachers and ECT's starting in September in Gymnastics
- * Support interventions aimed at children struggling with behaviour at break and dinnertimes
- * Deliver interventions for SEND pupils, children who struggle with gross motor skills and confidence in PE
- * Attend and hosting SEND festivals.
- * Buy new equipment to allow children to experience new sports such as Lacrosse and quick sticks hockey.
- * Develop of physical activity across the school from EYFS to year 6 with Get Set 4 PE, allowing staff and students to benefit from a progressive curriculum and opportunities for CPD.



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
